#### **ORDERS**

- Upon placing your order, an acknowledgement will be sent via email (fax or mail available upon request). Please verify billing and shipping addresses; plant, tag and pot quantities; ship date; and advise us of any discrepancies.
- Please include your State Nursery Certificate/Live Plant License or Landscape Contractor's License and Sales Tax Exemption Number with your first order.
- MINIMUM ORDER The minimum order size for shipping is 12 trays. There is no minimum for pickup orders. We are unable to split trays.
- TRAY SIZE Liners are produced in 32, 36 and 38 count trays. Tray size depends on what the
  production manager thinks fits the variety best. We are unable to guarantee a specific size tray.
- RESTOCKING FEE A 25% restocking fee will be charged if an order has been confirmed and
  pulled but cancelled prior to shipping.
- HOLDING FEE a 20% holding fee will be charged on orders not picked up within two weeks of the scheduled date.
- HANDLING FEE All ground shipments (less than a pallet / 12 trays) will be charged a 15% small order handling fee. Minimum fee \$50.

- All sales cash, check, credit card, or money order unless credit has been established.







resistant.




Buddleia davidii 'BD-02-21'

Punch™ performs well in the landscape.






Cascade Dream™ Distylium(Zone 7-9) (1.5' h x 3-4' w) Brings a

Distylium 'T3-01-22' PPAF, Titan™
Distylium- (Zone 7-9) (6-10' h x 4-8' w)
It is a large leaf, an upright selection.
New growth is coppery yellow-green,
maturing to lustrous dark green. Small
red flowers emerge from the leaf axils in
March-April. Ideal for screenings, hedges,
tall masses, or as a stand-alone accent
plant.






Loropetalum chinense var. rubrum 'LRD-02-20' PP34,955 Garnet Flame™ Fringe Flower- (Zone 7-9) (2-3' h x 3-4' w) Selected for its primarily black-purple foliage and uniform, compact spreading habit. Exuberant rose-red flowers appear in March-April with slight rebloom throughout the summer into early fall. Responds well to pruning and can be maintained at a desired size. Superb option for year-round foliage and flower color. Deer resistant, cold hardy to 2° F.



P36,142 Ivory Palace™ Gardenia-(Zone 7-9) (2' h x 4' w) Has fragrant, double white flowers with a compact, mounded habit. The 2 to 3" diameter flowers open in May-June in astronomical profusion, continuing sporadically into fall. Foliage is a leathery, lustrous dark green. It is ideal for container use and trafficked areas where passersby will enjoy the sweet floral perfume. Cold hardy to 2° F. Deer resistant.




Gardenia jasminoides 'ST-07-20' PP34,958 Stairway to Heaven™ Gardenia- (Zone 7-9) (3-4' h x 2-3' w) Develops a broad columnar habit, producing flowers and foliage like Ivory Palace™. It was bred from the same parents as Ivory Palace™. Cold hardy to 2° F. Deer resistant.



Hydrangea macrophylla 'CE-01-20' PP35,124 Rise-n-Shine™ Hydrangea- (Zone 6-9) (2-3' h x 2-3' w) Has shiny, thick-textured, beautiful yellow foliage that holds its color all season. The mophead flowers are pink without aluminum, light blue to deep purple with aluminum. Stems are extraordinarily strong and hold flowers upright. Does not rebloom.








Hydrangea macrophylla 'RLL-12-20' PP35,125 Midnight Rider™ **Hydrangea-** (Zone 6-9)  $(3-4' h \times 3-4' w)$ Deep maroon foliage, strong stems, and pink mophead inflorescences bring an element of Halloween to the garden. Foliage emerges the deepest blackmaroon, maturing bronze-green. The pink flowers contrast with the foliage. Partial rebloomer.



Hydrangea macrophylla 'SC-05-20' PP35,127 Show Stopper™ Hydrangea- (Zone 6-9)  $(3' h \times 4' w)$ Endowed with rich, deep rose to purple mophead inflorescences, lustrous dark green leaves with red veins and petioles. glistening red stems, compact habit, and reblooming proficiency. Foliage turns deep red and maroon in autumn. (The foliage is resistant to Cercospora hydrangeae, which induces red-brown lesions/spots on many Hydrangea macrophylla.)



Hydrangea macrophylla 'RRxAS-01-22' PPAF Blushing Blues™ **Hydrangea-** (Zone 6-9)  $(3-5' h \times 3-5' w)$ A cross between two remontant cultivars, Rock-n-Roll™ and Show Stopper™, is an Endless Summer® The Orginial® bookend with increased remontancy and stronger stems. The mophead flowers are bright pink to Cape Cod blue, slightly deeper blue than the Original®. In Watkinsville, GA, it flowered until November on new shoots. Wise to remove spent inflorescences to induce new shoot growth and flowers.



Lagerstroemia 'BD-01-20' PP35,292 Raspberry Jubilee™ Crapemyrtle-(Zone 6-10) (4.5' h x 6' w) Bountiful raspberry red flowers (July-August) blanket the lustrous dark green, diseaseresistant foliage. The emerging leaves are bronze-red and effective until flowers arrive. In fall, leaves develop a maroon patina. The six-year-old original plant is a perfect mound with not a stray shoot.

\*\*These varieties were bred by Dr. Scott NeSmith, emeritus professor, University of Georgia. Dr. Scott NeSmith is internationally recognized for his numerous commercial blueberry varieties. PII asked him to assist with garden-friendly blueberries, which led to Candelabra® and Sugar Snap®. Both varieties require 350-450 chill hours to produce large, sweet powder blue fruits. Each is self-fruitful and does not require another clone/cultivar to pollinate. Both varieties exhibit beautiful orange, red, and purple autumnal hues.



Vaccinium corymbosum 'TO-1719' PP34,934 Candelabra® Blueberry-(Zone 5-9) (5-6' h  $\times$  5-6' w) An early ripening cultivar with an upright, sprawling habit.



Vaccinium Sugar Snap®

Vaccinium corymbosum 'TH-1093' PP34,912 Sugar Snap® Highbush **Blueberry-** (Zone 5-9) (4-5' h x 4-5' w) A midseason ripening cultivar, not quite as tall as Candelabra. Has attractive, blueish silver foliage.

Cryptomeria japonica 'PIICJ-I', First Editions® Chapel View™ Japanese Cedar- (Zone 6) (7-10' h x 5-6' w) A beautiful, restrained, raindrop-shaped, blue-green needled evergreen shrub. Densely foliaged to the base with upswept branches. Lustrous blue-green color persists year-round. Free of brown male cones typically produced by Cryptomeria.

Distylium 'PIIDIST-V' PP27,631, First Editions® Cinnamon Girl® Distylium- (Zone 7) (3' h x 5 w') A mounding selection from Plant Introductions, Inc. with small, narrow and fine-textured foliage that emerges with a blue-purple tint. A different texture than PII's other Distylium introductions.

Distylium 'PIIDIST-III' PP25,304, First Editions® Coppertone™ Distylium- (Zone 7) (4' h x 5' w) Dense evergreen with bronze-purple new growth that matures to dark bluish green. Compact, rounded to spreading growth habit. Petite red flowers in winter. Full sun to moderate shade; tolerates drought, heat, wet soil and exceptional resistance to disease & insects. Bred by Plant Introductions, Inc.

Distylium 'PIIDIST-IV' PP25,984, First Editions® Linebacker™ Distylium- (Zone 7) (8-10' h x 6-8' w) Compact, upright growth habit. Reddish new growth matures to a lustrous leathery dark green. Same resistance to insects & disease as other Distylium and tolerant of wet and dry soils. Bred by Plant Introductions, Inc.

Sarcococca confusa- (Zone 6) (3') Evergreen shrub for the shade. Dark green foliage and fragrant white flowers in Feb. make this under used plant a winner. Beautiful fruit go from a red to black.

Sarcococca hookeriana- (Zone 5) (4') I came across this plant at Hilliers Arboretum in England, in their winter garden. The fragrance of the border planting in bloom in early March was incredible. This selection is from seed collected in the wild from Nepal. Dark green evergreen foliage prefers shade.

**Sarcococca orientalis-** (Zone 6) (3' h x 4' w) Dark green evergreen shrub for partial shade to shade. Fragrant white flowers in early winter followed by shiny black fruit. Larger foliage and tighter growth habit than S. confusa.

Spiraea x bumalda 'Anthony Waterer'- (Zone 3) (4' tall and wide) Green foliage with dark pink flowers.

**Spiraea japonica 'Goldmound'-** (Zone 3) (2') Low mounding cultivar with pink flowers and yellow foliage.

Spiraea x bumalda 'Magic Carpet'-(Zone 3) (1.5') Low growing cultivar with pink flowers and orange/red new growth. Introduced by David Tristram of the United Kingdom. RHS Award of Garden Merit winner.

Spiraea japonica 'Neon Flash'-(Zone 4) (3' tall and wide) Similar to Anthony Waterer but with red flowers and reddish new growth.

Syringa pubescens subsp. julianae 'Red Pixie'- (Zone 3)(6' h x 6' w) In an attempt to find a lilac that performs in the South, Plant Introductions Inc. brought in every species and cultivar they could find and planted them in the field for evaluation. A couple of years later, 'Red Pixie' is the only one remaining and thriving. 'Red Pixie' has also thrived as a container and liner. The dark reddish purple flowers arrive in early April in Zone 7. Wonderfully fragrant!

**Thuja occidentalis 'Degroot's Spire'**-(Zone 3) (6-12' h x 3-5' w) A narrow columnar form with dark green fern-like shaped sprays. Twisted foliage, bronzes in cold weather.

Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald Green' ('Smaragd')- (Zone 3) (15') A narrow compact pyramidal form with emerald green foliage.

Thuja plicata 'Green Splendor'-(Zone 5) (50') Fast growing like 'Green Giant' but more columnar in growth habit. Has held dark green foliage throughout the winter. (32cp)

**Thuja x 'Green Giant'-** (Zone 5) (40') Fast growing with broad pyramidal growth habit.

Trachelospermum asiaticum 'HOSNS', Snow-N-Summer™-(Zone 7) (4-6" h x 3" w) A beautiful evergreen accent groundcover with new growth exhibiting colors of copper, white with green splotches and white with soft to medium pink leaves. Best color in light shade to part sun. Variegation persists into winter months. Price includes \$0.35 trademark fee.


**Viburnum awabuki 'Chindo'**- (Zone 7) (15') Dark glossy green foliage. Excellent for screening.

**Viburnum plicatum f. plicatum 'Popcorn'-** (Zone 5) (8' h x 8' w) A dense upright deciduous shrub with 6-inch white flowers in April – May. Dark green foliage with red-purple fall color. 2012 RHS Award of Garden Merit recipient.

**Viburnum tinus 'Spring Bouquet'**-(Zone 7) (6') Evergreen Viburnum with pink buds in the winter followed by light pink flowers in the spring.

Vitex agnus-castus 'Shoal Creek'-(Zone 6) (12') A superior cultivar with lilac fragrant flowers from June-Sept. Vigorous grower with clean foliage. Introduced by Goodness Grows in Lexington, GA.

Wisteria frutescens 'Amethyst Falls'- (Zone 5) (20') Deep lavender-blue fragrant flowers in mid-April. Reblooms throughout the summer. Much easier to maintain than other wisterias.


